"We created the MRM - Banner Import Utility to ensure that our MRM calendar always reflects the academic course schedule. By integrating classes and other events in a single calendar, it's much easier to share our prime facilities and avoid scheduling conflicts. In short, our challenge was sharing space, and keeping off each other's toes, while still offering a single calendar for our users," Trenthem said.

NetSimplicity has implemented the Banner Import Utility as a standard offering within Meeting Room Manager so that other Banner users could enjoy this capability. By integrating their curricular and extracurricular scheduling systems, institutions of higher education unlock the potential to optimally use their facilities. This benefits them by:

- Enabling faculty and staff to view room schedules and find available space for extracurricular events via MRM's easy-to-use web interface
