

Busy IT Asset Managers Spur Launch of VAM 2004+

NetSimplicity updates Visual Asset Manager software

Additionally, VAM 2004+ contains features such enhanced reports, new search capabilities and user interface performance enhancements, all in response to requests from IT manager users.

"As a rule, IT asset managers have a lot on their plate and lead pretty hectic lives," said Nancy Harris, vice president of software at NetSimplicity. "We've added new features to VAM 2004+ that will make it easier and improve their efficiencies when it comes to managing a company's IT assets."

Harris added that conversations with IT managers during the past year confirmed the VAM 2004+ release was on the right track, particularly with regard to the Asset Check In/Out feature.

VAM 2004+ comes in two versions to meet the needs and budgets of any size organization and a range of options are also available. The Lite Version starts at \$399 while the Pro Version starts at \$2,299.
