## NetSimplicity Launches Meeting Room Manager V7 Enterprise

### Features Outlook(R) Scheduling and Other Enterprise Capabilities

In addition to the Outlook integration, MRM 7 contains a host of other powerful new features including user group synchronization with Microsoft Active Directory®, wait list capability for highly utilized rooms, and the ability to have different booking processes for different locations.

"Among the many new useful features, I absolutely love the multiple tabs for multiple rooms functionality," Schroeder said. "This allows us to have multiple reservation processes, for different rooms and locations with separate requirements, and we'll be able to eliminate booking mistakes because rooms and resources will have their own unique booking processes based on their location."

"We are pleased to deliver MRM V7 to market and believe it will continue the heritage of MRM being the most robust product on the market for the price," said Nancy Harris, Vice President of NetSimplicity. "This new version reflects the input of our valued customers who have requested capabilities such as Outlook Scheduling, Active Directory Synchronization and other features that our customers need to make room and resource scheduling even easier."

Other key enhancements in MRM 7 include:

- Priority booking rights, to allow select users or user groups to override existing room and resource reservations and bump those reservations to the wait list to accommodate higher-priority bookings.
- Enhancements to the booking process to better accommodate multi-room bookings with distinct service requests for each room.
- New reports, improved e-mail reminders, new administration tools, and a host of user interface enhancements designed to create more flexibility for end-users to get the room and resource they need, and to further increase the comprehensive control administrators have over the entire scheduling process.
